Each year, an estimated 1.7 million people sustain a traumatic brain injury (TBI). Of those injured, 1.365 million are treated and released from an emergency department, 275,000 are hospitalized, and 52,000 die.

Almost half a million (473,947) of the emergency department visits for TBI are children aged 0 to 14 years.
